## The Issue of Heartworm

Straight facts on the real and perceived dangers of heartworm.

What I think is most important to emphasize, is just how perfect the conditions have to be for a dog to get heartworm in the first place. This is a bit of a long story (and believe it or not, made short) so bear with me.

The heartworm has five separate larval stages, referred to simply as L1, L2, L3, L4 and L5. It also has two separate cycles which have to be combined to complete the lifecycle of the heartworm. Only one cycle takes place in the mosquito and the other inside the dog.

The mosquito becomes infested when it bites a dog which is already harboring L1 (Microfilariae). This can only happen if the dog is also harboring the L5, which is the adult, male and female heartworm as the Microfilariae are their offspring. The Microfilariae can live for up to two years in the dog's blood but must be taken up by a mosquito in order to develop any further. If they are not taken up by a mosquito, they will simply die off.

Once the mosquito is infested, the larvae must then go through two stages of development (L2 and L3) before they can infect another dog. This stage takes anywhere from two weeks to several months depending on the weather. The warmer the weather the faster the development, hence the higher incidence in southern states.

While the larvae are developing within the mosquito, the temperature **MUST** remain above 57 degrees Fahrenheit at all times, day and night. If at any time during the mosquito stage the temperature drops below 57° F, the development is halted and it must start all over again. It is only the L3 larva which are capable of infesting your dog.

So, let's say that a mosquito has bitten an infested dog and the temperature has remained above 57° F for a minimum of 14 days since that bite and the mosquito bites your dog. Your dog will **not** be infested because the L3 larvae are deposited in a tiny droplet of mosquito saliva adjacent to the bite **not** actually injected into your dog as many would have us believe.

Providing the droplet does not evaporate, the L3 larvae must then swim through the droplet of saliva and into the mosquito bite, thereby entering your dog's system. Once inside your dog the L3 larvae must spend the next two weeks or so developing into the L4 larva. During this period of time the larvae is living in the skin, not the blood of the newly infested dog. The L4 will continue to live and develop in the skin for the next three or four months where it will finally develop into the L5 stage.

Once it makes this development into the L5 it then leaves the skin and enters the circulatory system. The L5 or young adult then migrates to the heart and pulmonary arteries. Once there it will mate approximately five to seven months after entering the dog's body. That is, of course, assuming that the dog has been infested with both male and female larvae. This mating produces the Microfilariae, which would then repeat the cycle outlined above.

Mosquitoes cause heartworm, so prevention of mosquito bites will prevent heartworm, simple. There are natural insect repellents that will help prevent your pet from being bitten. Nature's Guard from Prescribed Animal Wellness Solutions is one of them, and also a great product for repelling fleas, ticks, black flies and mosquitoes (if we do say so ourselves). Brewer's yeast and garlic are said to be helpful in preventing bites.

Also, as a preventative, Black Walnut Tincture (also available at Prescribed Animal Wellness) will prevent any possible infestations. If one feels their possible exposure warrants a second level of protection.

It's about weighing your odds of exposure, you have to do what's right for your own animals and your situation. But heartworm meds such as "Heartgard" are **NOT** preventatives, there are in fact toxic pesticides designed to kill the heartworm larvae in the blood before they can develop into adults and migrate to the heart and lungs.

So, for example, spring and fall are the body's liver cleansing times of year and as such we have included herbs like dandelion, red clover, plantain and burdock root, which help cleanse and tonify the liver.

By providing these plants in their whole-food form, they are providing a wide range of nutritional benefits that the body recognizes as food sources.

Why do pets need herbal supplements? Simply put, prevention of a disease is much easier than curing a disease. Herbs harmony the 'Yin and Yang' of the body, and make the body immune to, or more resistant against, many serious diseases. According to Health Canada, a functional food is "consumed as part of a usual diet that is similar in appearance to, or may be, a conventional food, and is demonstrated to have physiological benefits and/or reduce the risk of chronic disease beyond basic nutritional functions."

Functional foods may come from plants or animals. Active ingredients effective in promoting health include amino acids, fats, dietary fibres, antioxidants, pigments, vitamins and minerals.

Herbs can be used freely and safely as part of one's lifestyle without thinking of them as 'medicines'. For specific health needs, their best use would be preventative -- to prevent problems appearing. There are specific herbs that strengthen and tone specific organs and systems. By using herbs it may well be possible to overcome any weakness.

Because these thyroid hormones regulate metabolism in every cell of the body and play a role in virtually all physiological functions, an iodine deficiency can have a devastating impact on overall health and well-being.

## Product Highlight — Colloidal Silver

The Natural Antibiotic Alternative

Antibiotic-resistant germs are now considered epidemic in North America, accounting for a growing number of serious infections both externally and internally. While most antibiotics destroy about a half-dozen or so germs, silver has been reported to disinfect several hundred. Most importantly, unlike conventional antibiotics, germs cannot build a resistance to the action of silver.

When properly prepared, colloidal silver is a completely non-toxic, tasteless, broad-spectrum germ fighter that can be used internally or externally. Although the exact mechanism for the proven antimicrobial effects of silver is unknown, the most accepted theory is that silver disables the specific enzyme that many forms of bacteria, viruses and fungi utilize for their metabolism.

There have been some media reports of skin discolouration, known as Argyria, which can result when hundreds of times the proper amount of silver compounds are injected or taken orally. However, when a quality product is used properly such phenomenon will not occur.

One indicator of the quality of colloidal silver is its colour. As the size of each silver particle gets larger, the colour of the suspension ranges from yellow (best) to brown, to red, to gray to black (inferior). The ideal form of colloidal silver will be almost colourless or have a very light yellow colour.

When taken orally, sublingual absorption in the mouth directly into the bloodstream should occur before the silver particles have the opportunity to migrate into the small or large intestine where intestinal bacteria normally dominate. A 3 to 5 ppm (parts per million) concentration should be used for internal purposes. Prescribed Animal Wellness Solutions is a 10 ppm solution, so diluted in the pets drinking water is the best administration for internal purposes.

## Product Highlight — Diatomaceous Earth

Flea and Internal Parasite treatment



### Characteristics of Diatomaceous Earth

Diatomaceous earth (DE) refers to a naturally-formed sedimentary mineral coming from the remains of what were once oceanic unicellular shells and algae known as diatoms. Diatoms, the ocean's "spiny honeycombs," are over 30 million years old, and were formed when these microscopic algae-like plants died and remained compounded in the earth's surface as skeletal remains. These organisms emit lime-carbonate and has the ability to emit silica. Scientists refer to these clay-like, chalky remains as diatomite. When we mine the earth, we discover these remains in the form of a thick white siliceous powder.

### Alternative Health Properties of Diatomaceous Earth

Food grade diatomaceous earth offers important benefits, particularly related to the fact that it is composed of approximately 85% amorphous silica. Silica is such a necessary component for the health of tendons, cartilage, blood vessels, and bones. It is also needed for the health and strength of skin, teeth and nails. It even contributes to the health of almost all vital organs, including the heart, liver and lungs.

A strong abrasive, DE is composed of a unique combination of 33% silicon, 19% calcium, 5% sodium, 3% magnesium and 2% iron, as well fifteen other trace minerals like boron, manganese, titanium, copper and zirconium.

DE acts as a mild abrasive in animals, removing intestinal invaders and other harmful organisms from the digestive tract, stimulating digestion and absorption of nutrients by sweeping foreign bodies out of the system. Diatomaceous Earth is also chocked-full of naturally occurring trace minerals.

Encourage them to drink water after they take colostrum.

Some first time users of bovine (cow) colostrum may experience a "healing crisis" as the body begins to release toxins stored in the cells. This can cause abdominal discomfort, headaches, diarrhea, nausea, gas, cough, rash or a low grade fever. These symptoms can last from two days to a week. ## Enzymes & Probiotics

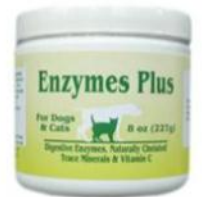
Promotes healthy digestion and good intestinal flora

Enzymes are required for every single chemical action that takes place in your pet's body. All of the cells, organs, bones, muscles, and tissues are run by enzymes. Your pet's health is directly related to the exhaustion of their enzyme potential.

The digestive system, immune system, blood stream, liver, kidneys, spleen, and pancreas, as well as the ability to see, think, and breathe, all depend on enzymes. All of the minerals and vitamins obtained through food and all of the hormones the body produces need enzymes in order to work properly. In fact, every single metabolic function in the body is governed by enzymes. As it happens, they are produced both internally (most notably in the pancreas and the other endocrine glands) and are present in raw foods that are fed. Enzymes are lost during cooking and processing of commercial foods. Digestive enzymes increase the absorption of nutrients from food by breaking it down smaller. Some enzymes are naturally present in fresh foods, but are easily lost during cooking and processing of commercial foods. Digestive enzymes added to the food helps relieve the strain placed on the digestive process when naturally occurring enzymes aren't present and can help prevent gastrointestinal problems caused by food intolerance, allergy, illness, stress and use of antibiotics.

### Enzymes Plus

A beneficial blend of digestive enzymes, kelp and whole food sources of vitamin C and bioflavonoids. Kelp is the best source of trace minerals such as copper, iodine, iron and zinc. Vitamin C enhances immune function, improves overall physical well-being and reduces the incidence and severity of age related illnesses. Bioflavonoids are known to enhance the effects of Vitamin C. These four digestive enzymes provide the enzymes that will assist in digesting the main components of a cat or dog's diet.

### Good Digestion

## **Chanca Piedra**

### Medicinal Qualities of Chanca Piedra "Break Stone"

In clinical research over the years, Chanca Piedra has demonstrated liver protective, antilithic (expelling stones), pain-relieving, hypotensive, antispasmodic, antiviral, antibacterial, diuretic, antimutagenic, and hypoglycemic activities. Since the 1960's there has been a growing body of scientific studies published on Chanca Piedra, to date over 300 studies have been carried out. Indian and Brazilian research groups were the first to conduct these studies since the plant was indigenous to their areas, with a long history of use by their inhabitants. The Brazilian researchers have summarized their research stating, "Pre-clinical and clinical studies carried out with the extracts and purified compounds from these plants support most of their reported uses in folk medicine for the treatment of a wide variety of pathological conditions."

### **Kidney, Gall Stones & Cholesterol**

Research done in Brazil at the Federal University of Santa Catarina in 1984 on Chanca Piedra revealed an alkaloid (phyllanthoside) in the leaves and stem with strong antispasmodic activity. It served as a relaxing agent for smooth muscles and they concluded that its spasmolytic action probably accounted for the efficacy of Chanca Piedra in expelling stones.

With the introduction of Chanca Piedra, health care practitioners have acquired a powerful plant ally in helping their patients to maintain optimal kidney, gall bladder, liver, and bladder health. In a 1999 study, researchers confirmed that Chanca Piedra has a potent and effective inhibitory effect on the formation of calcium-oxalate crystals and decreases the size of existing stones. Not only that, but also this effect was found even at very high levels of calcium oxalate, which indicates that it might be a useful preventative aid for pets with a history of kidney stones.

Chanca Piedra is also used in herbal medicine for gallstones and one study indicates that Chanca Piedra has an effect on gallbladder processes. Gallstones form when cholesterol and bile pigments become so concentrated that they form lumps inside the gallbladder.

Dr. Wolfram Wiemann of Nuremberg, Germany has used Chanca Piedra in his medical practice in Germany. He reported 94% of all the cases he encountered among his patients of gallstones and kidney stones were "completely eliminated" within one or two weeks. Another Amazon physician interviewed by Nicole Maxwell, about the use of Chanca Piedra for his patients said that the plant worked 100% of the time without any side effects

### **Future Studies**

Researchers have suggested that another promising area for future study would be the use of Chanca Piedra in treatment of Lyme's Disease. Since syphilis is caused by a spirochete and Chanca Piedra has traditionally been used for this illness, it would be a good study for the epidemic of Lyme's Disease, which we are experiencing the northeastern United States, since Lyme's is also caused by a spirochete.
